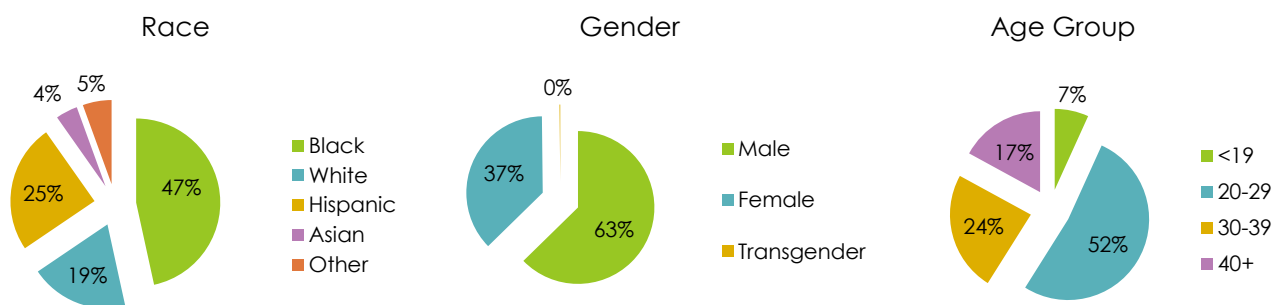


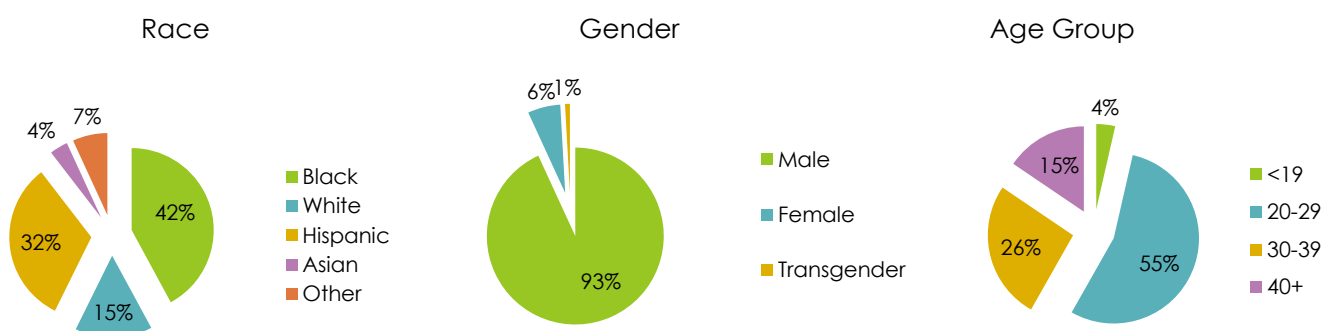
BSTDC Clinic Summary

Patients visiting BSTDC clinics in 2014 tended to be **people of color, male, and young (<29)**. These three demographic characteristics either held true or were more likely in the subset of newly diagnosed HIV-positive patients.

Demographics of newly diagnosed **HIV-positive patients** visiting BSTDC clinics, 2014

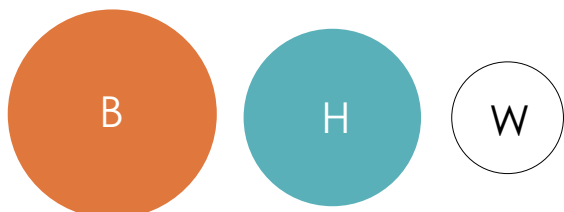


Of the 365 newly diagnosed positive test results in 2013...

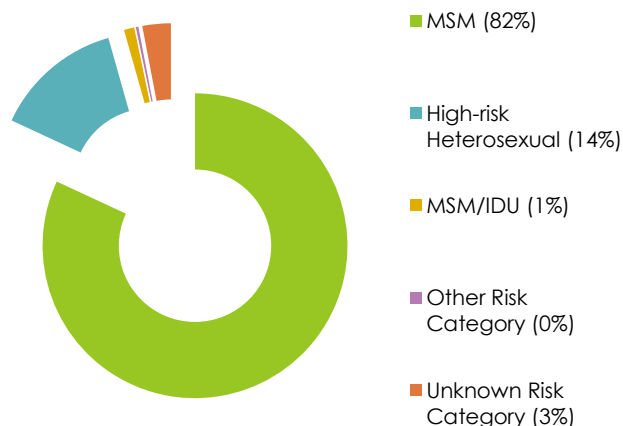
93% were men, **7%** were women, **0%** transgender.



42% identified as Black/African American
32% Hispanic, and **16%** White.



82% reported MSM as a risk factor, while **14%** reported high-risk heterosexual.
