**Welcome/Introductions/Moment of Silence/Review of the Meeting Packet/Review of the Minutes:** Committee Co-Chairs Lisa Zullig and Christopher Joseph welcomed meeting participants. Attendees introduced themselves. Janet Goldberg led the moment of silence. After extensive discussion, a sentence from the minutes about staff members being

traumatized by delivering diagnoses was excised. The revised minutes were accepted for posting on the Planning Council website at nyhiv.org.

**EIS Service Directive:** IOC members and guests agreed on the following points regarding the draft service directive:

- Use of the term “trauma-Informed”: Planning Council and grantee staff will draft some material for the committee on the meaning of the term “trauma-informed” and provide information about available trainings and a list of resources, keeping in mind that this term is really more applicable to behavioral health services than to testing and linkage.
- Visual clarity: Planning Council staff agreed to increase the clarity of the document with two steps: 1) enhancing readability by better delineating services relevant just to testing and services relevant to testing and linkage to care and 2) placing each column on its own page.

**Next Meeting:** Committee members and guests made the following requests/promises for the next meeting:

- Peter Laqueur asked that the next meeting begin with a presentation on what is and what isn’t working with health homes.
- Jan Carl Park noted that the next meeting would begin with a discussion about expanding Ryan White legal services to include immigration-related work. Grantee staff will bring suggested language to the IOC Committee.
- Janet Goldberg asked for a summary of where Obama is regarding legal services for the undocumented.
- Committee members agreed to start the next meeting on March 18<sup>th</sup> at 9:30 am.
