Care Coordination Standard of Care Line-by-Line Editing

- Struck field based from the document to remove association with slavery
 - Discussion of best language followed: home, community based, and off-site.
- Stigmatizing language was dismantled to the best of the group's ability with Ms. Simon's leadership.
 - Attempted to shift the focus to systemic barriers and not on individuals and populations
- Substitution of the word inequity for disparity
- Vulnerable groups/target populations shift over time
- Debated inclusion of peer support and included it as a best practice
- Everyone needs self-management skills. Document required clarity.
- Clarification on how a person would gain entry into the program, particularly if they are from out of state.
- Staff can do the work of those with lower qualifications but not vice versa.
- Debate about how to best represent process of re-assessment
- Removal of word escort
- Many grammatical changes
- Standards of Care will be put on hold until the master directive can be reviewed and updated to reflect desired changes
